It's been a huge privilege to see the educational opportunities we dreamed of being realised in this place. Children learning, growing, having fun, sharing community and love.

The following is a list of useful information and points to note – organised alphabetically for reference.

Attendance

Our pupil attendance for last year was a little over 95% and we are seeking to improve that this year to well above the government target of 96%. We can only do this with your support. Avoidable absences are very disruptive to a child; even a 5% absence rate means a whole morning's learning lost every two weeks. Requests for absence must be put in writing for the attention of Mr Taylor as far in advance as possible and will only be authorised if the circumstances are exceptional. Please note holidays during term time will not be authorised. We would like to celebrate all pupils who make it through each half term with 100% attendance.

Car parking

With so many families and staff at St Gabriel's you will notice the car park is feeling very busy at the start and end of the day. We would encourage as many families as possible to walk, cycle or scooter to school. We are running road safety awareness classes this year for all year groups in partnership with Warwickshire county council. If you need to travel some distance to get to school, please consider parking a little way away and walking the rest. We hope that as Houlton continues to develop, more of the road that runs past the school will open with a roundabout creating the ability to drop off without having to reverse. If you do use the car park, please take extra

care during busy times. Please reserve the disabled access parking spaces for those

that require them.

Punctuality

To ensure the best possible start to the day and to help prepare our children well for learning, it is so important that they are in school on time for morning registration at 9am. The school gate to the playground opens just before 8:45am every day and closes just before 9am. Aiming to arrive **for 8:45** should ensure children are always on time.

School meals

From October Half term, we will be slightly increasing the price of school meals for children in Years 3-6 by 5p to £2.35 This represents a 2% increase since the start of last year and ensures the school can cope with rising costs.

Snacks

Children are welcome to bring a snack of fruit to school. Children in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 are provided with free fruit as part of the School Fruit and Vegetable Scheme.

Uniform

Thank you for helping us to make the pupils look so smart at the start of the year.
