## **Cold Weather**

Please ensure that children are well protected against the cold and any coats, hats, gloves, scarves are clearly named so that they don't get lost. Give yourself an extra few minutes in the morning to get to school safely and take care on the paths and approaches to the school.

## **Attendance and Punctuality**

Your child's consistent attendance is so important to their education. At this time of year, illnesses may seem more prevalent but we ask that you make every effort to bring your child in to school unless you deem them too unwell to take part in normal school activities. If your child has a sickness and diarrhoea bug, we ask that you keep them off for 48 hours after the last episode before returning to school. Thank you for the concerted efforts to be punctual over the past few weeks. In winter, journeys inevitably take longer so leave yourselves plenty of time to arrive at or just before **8:45am** so that everyone can be safely inside on time by **9am**.

#### **Medicine administration**

We would always prefer children to be in school if they are well enough and occasionally, they may need a bit of medicine to get them through the day. This can be prescribed medicine, for example antibiotics or non-prescribed i.e. Calpol, etc. If your child needs any medication, as far as possible, parents/guardians should come in to give their child the medication at the time required. We appreciate that this is not always feasible and in exceptional circumstances our 'duty of care' extends to administering medication on your behalf when possible. Whilst there is no legal duty for school staff to administer any medication, this is down to our discretion and we will endeavour to help as much as we can with prescribed medication taking priority. Thank you for your support and co-operation in this regard.

#### **Car Parking**

At this time of year, the car park is busier than ever at drop off and pick up time. Please take extra special care not to rush, be patient with all users and especially watch out for children moving towards the gate. A slow walking pace should be the maximum speed of any car. If you can park safely off-site and walk the rest of your journey, please do so.

## **Campfire Carols**

On Thursday 12<sup>th</sup> December the school community is invited to join together at 5pm for Christmas Carols sung around a campfire in our grounds. Please come wrapped up to meet on the playground before the signing begins. A hot drink and mince pie will be available! If the weather is poor, the event will take place in the school.
