Mrs Dowler is an experienced specialist leader of Early Years education and we are delighted she will be based in our Reception class each Monday-Wednesday, working alongside Miss Magowan and the team. This in turn

will allow Miss Magowan to gain experience in Year 1 on a short placement later in the term, working alongside Miss Randle to build a view on the journey our pupils make from Reception to Year 1.

Mrs Bemrose will be taking the lead in Year 3 as she supports children building on their start in the lower school. Meanwhile, Year 6 will benefit from the expertise of Mrs Roberts and Mrs Garner as our English and Maths leaders, to ensure they secure all the skills required to transition to secondary school effectively.
