Things to remember:

Children need to bring in a named water bottle every day and if they would like to, they may bring in a piece of fruit for a snack at playtime.

Your child will need to bring their PE kit every Thursday (Bell) / Wednesday (Windsor). Children will bring home one Phonics book and one library book each week. Their Phonics book will be changed every Monday and Thursday and their library book will be changed every Friday. No library books will be changed the last week of each half term.

Home Learning:

Throughout their time in Year 1, children are expected to engage in a variety of home learning activities to support their understanding and learning of the content they have been taught. We use the online platform 'Seesaw' to set home learning tasks and for children to upload completed activities. As well as directed learning tasks, we are also keen to see any other learning or activities children take part in. The children will receive Phonics and spelling homework each week with a Maths activity at the end of each Maths unit.

We believe Reading is the most important skill children learn during their time with us. In Year 1, we expect children to read regularly and for this reading to be recorded in their Reading Records. There is also a high expectation for children to complete their Phonics tasks each week. Children have access to a range of online learning platforms, such as Spelling Shed, which help them develop their key skills. Phonics Play is also a great resource for some interactive games.
