### Things to remember:

Children will be provided with a fruit snack if they would like one, but you can also provide your child with their own fruit for break time if you would prefer. ### Home Learning:

Throughout their time in Year 2, children are expected to engage in a variety of home learning activities which help to consolidate their learning from the week.

We use the online platform 'Seesaw' to set home learning tasks and children can then upload their completed activities. As well as directed learning tasks, we are also keen to see any other learning or activities children take part in.



We believe reading is the most important skill children learn during their time with us. In Year 2, we expect children to read regularly and for this reading to be recorded in their Reading Records.

Children also have access to a range of online learning platforms such as Spelling Shed and Maths Shed which help them develop their key skills.
