#### Things to remember:

As a school, we like to encourage healthy eating habits. Children will need to bring with them a named water bottle and they can also bring some fruit to enjoy at playtime. Hopper Class have PE on a Wednesday morning and can attend school wearing their PE kit but must remember to bring their unform to change into afterwards. Turing Class have their PE lessons on a Monday afternoon.



In Year 4, pupils will have to take the statutory Multiplication Tables Check. This takes place in the Summer Term and will test their understanding of times tables from 0  $\times$  0 to 12  $\times$  12.

#### Home Learning:

Whilst in Year 4, children are expected to engage in a variety of home learning activities which support them in knowing more and remembering more of the content we teach. It is also an opportunity for our pupils to develop their independent study skills and learn what it takes to become an independent learner.

We use the online platform 'Seesaw' to set home learning tasks and for children to upload completed activities. As well as directed learning tasks, we are also keen to see any other learning or activities children take part in.

We believe reading is the most important skill children learn during their time with us. In Year 4, we expect children to read regularly and for this reading to be recorded in their Reading Records. Books are changed on Mondays and Thursdays.

Children have access to a range of online learning platforms such as Times Tables Rock Stars and Spelling Shed which help them develop their key skills.
