## Things to remember:

Children need to bring in a named water bottle every day and if they would like to, they may bring in a piece of fruit for a snack at playtime.

The children will have an opportunity to change their reading books on Mondays and Thursdays. Books and Reading Records must be brought into school every day.

Your child will need to bring a PE kit to school each Friday.

#### Home Learning:

Throughout their time in Year 5, children are expected to engage in a variety of home learning activities which support them in knowing more and remembering more of the content we teach. It is also an opportunity for our pupils to develop their independent study skills in preparation for Year 6.

We use Seesaw, an online platform, to set home learning tasks and for children to upload completed activities. The children will be set an English and Maths task every week on Friday, which will need to be uploaded to Seesaw by the following Thursday. As well as directed learning tasks, we are also keen to see any other learning or activities children take part in.

We believe reading is the most important skill children learn during their time with us. In Year 5, we expect children to read regularly and for this reading to be recorded in their Reading Records. Books are changed on Mondays and Thursdays.

Children have access to a range of online learning platforms, such as Times Tables Rock Stars and Spelling Shed, which help them develop their key skills.
